As many of you are aware, FHSS is not holding its annual Congress in 2026, so ACP/CPA elected to hold an independent, in-person Congress in collaboration with fellow FHSS members: CSHPS (Canadian Society for the History and Philosophy of Science, CSHPM (Canadian Society for the History and Philosophy of Mathematics, and CSSPE (Canadian Society for the Study of Practical Ethics).
